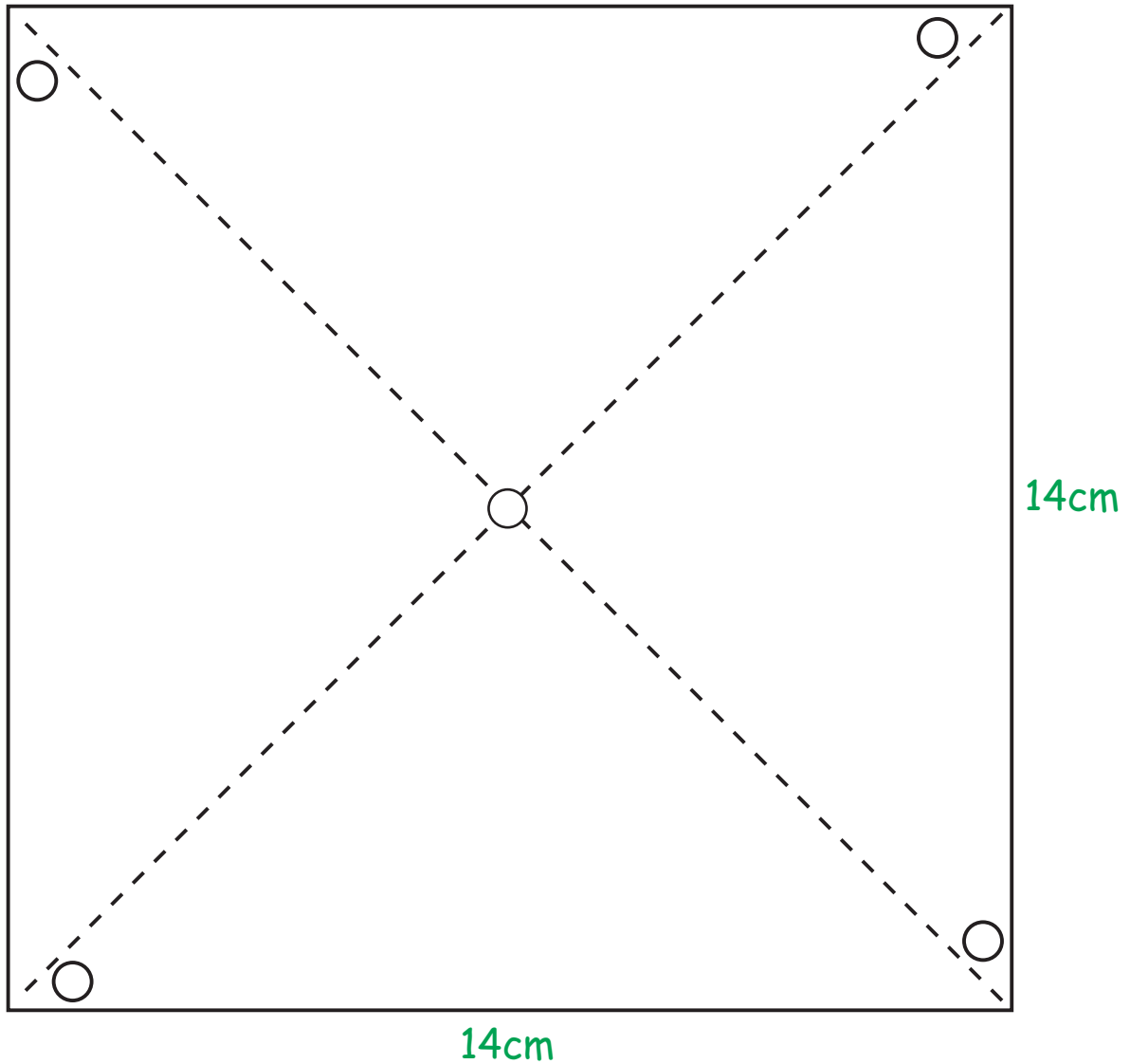




Windmills



- You will need:**
- Paper and scissors
 - Single hole punch
 - Split pins
 - Bendy plastic drinking straws



Windmills

1. Cut out the 14 cm x 14 cm square and use it as a template to cut out enough paper squares for each child.
2. Fold the paper square in half along one dotted line.
3. Fold the paper square along the other dotted line, so you have a triangle.
4. Using scissors, snip a tiny piece off the tip of the triangle.
5. Open out the square again. There should be a small hole in the middle.
6. Use a single hole punch to make four other holes, exactly as shown.
7. Cut halfway along the four dotted lines carefully, and then bend in the corners of the square as shown in the picture. Line up all the holes.
8. Push a split pin through all five holes, and open it up slightly at the back.
9. Bend the straw into an L-shape.
10. Push the split pin into the short end of the straw.
11. Now take your windmills outside on a windy day!
